OXFORD CERTIFICATE PROGRAMMES

at Worcester College offer students aged 15 and above the opportunity to experience Oxford and learn in an Oxford college setting. Upon satisfactory completion of the programme, participants receive a Certificate of Attendance and Achievement issued by Worcester College.

INSPIRING ACADEMIC COURSE

The Summer 2023 Oxford Certificate Programme at Worcester College offers a cutting-edge course taught by tutors from Oxford and Cambridge:

Philosophy, Politics and Economics

This course will give students an overview of these three core disciplines that underpin the society in which we live.

In Philosophy they will encounter some of history's greatest thinkers, the varying ways which they argue that human societies should be organised, and how to make decisions effectively for the wellbeing of all people.

Politics will involve students writing their own constitution for a theoretical country, learning how to negotiate between interest groups while responding to the international political environment.

Economics completes the course. After an introduction to core concepts such as supply and demand, market equilibrium, game theory, competition and trade, students will learn how to apply these concepts to financial and business decisions, product innovation and career choices, as well as the role of public policy in economic markets.
